

The Achieve Program at Noble and Greenough School STEAM Enrichment Teacher Job Description Summer 2025

Achieve partners with families from Boston to empower motivated students to challenge the opportunity gap. By providing transformative academic programming and enriching experiences from middle school through the first year in college, we foster enduring confidence and agency in our scholars through a supportive and joyful community.

Achieve students are motivated, high-achieving young people who grow into extraordinary individuals. Our middle school scholars attend Boston's district and charter public schools, come from low-income families, and represent diverse ethnicities, religions, and family backgrounds. Achieve seeks to increase our students' academic skills and sense of self and put them on the path to college.

This summer we are hoping to expand our enrichment offerings to widen our STEAM courses for students. We are looking for experienced performing arts, visual arts, engineering, and technology teachers to work with us this summer on a part-time basis. Candidates must possess a strong interest in working with urban students in a fun, challenging, and enriching academic environment.

Qualifications:

- Experience and/or interest in working with middle school students (grades 6 through 8)
- Subject matter expertise in visual art, performing arts, technology, engineering, or other STEAM field
- Demonstrated commitment to social and racial justice
- Strong ability to collaborate and communicate effectively
- Excellent organizational skills
- High energy and a sense of humor!

Responsibilities:

- Plan and lead an engaging enrichment course for small groups of students (45 minutes, twice a week for six weeks– 10 total sessions)
- Contribute to a nurturing environment with consistent communication among community members
- Carry out other duties as assigned by the directors

- Enrichment teachers will meet EITHER Monday & Wednesday, or Tuesday & Thursday from 12:45-1:30 PM from June 30-August 7 (no program July 4)
